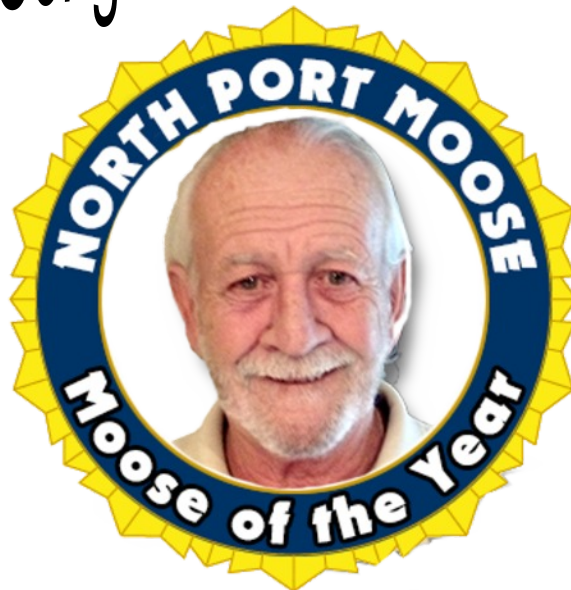
In June we all gathered and celebrated the life of our member Charlie Nelson. He will be be sadly missed.

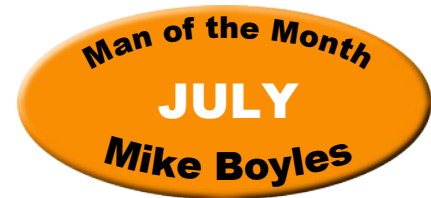

Supplies needed, Give-Away Day is August 2

As in years past, WOTM Chapter 1892 is collecting school supplies and money for school supplies so we can have enough for North Port school students (grades K through 5) on Saturday, August 2, from 10 AM - 12 noon

When you do your regular shopping, please pick up something to donate: note paper, pencils, pens, scissors, glue, erasers, rulers, etc., and drop them in the bin set up in the Moose Lodge lobby. Or, to make it easier for you, we'll do the shopping; you just donate cash in the marked donation jars on the bar.

August 2 will be here quickly and we want to make sure we don't have to turn away any child, so don't wait to donate.

Parents, when you bring in your children for supplies on August 2 make sure they have their North Port school supply list with them. Hours are 10 AM - 12 noon (unless all given away sooner) .

Water - at least 1 gallon daily per person for 3 to 7 days

Food - at least enough for 3 to 7 days

- non-perishable packaged or canned food / juices
- foods for infants or the elderly
- snack foods

•**non-electric can opener**

•cooking tools / fuel

First Aid Kit / Medicines / Prescription Drugs

Toiletries - hygiene items, Moisture wipes

Flashlight / Batteries

Radio - Battery operated and NOAA weather radio

Cash - Banks and ATMs may not be open

Keys

Important documents - in waterproof container

- insurance, medical records, bank account numbers, Social Security card, etc.

Tools - keep a set with you during the storm

Vehicle fuel tanks filled

Pet care items

- proper identification / immunization records
- ample **supply of food and water, a carrier or cage, medications, muzzle and leash.**



It was just shy of 10 years ago that Hurricane Charley roared through our neighborhoods and many folks have become complacent. Various weather experts have forecast 9 -12 named storms this season. Will one hit Florida, particularly, this region? Your guess is as good as the experts.

But don't just guess and hope. Get ready now before a storm is forecast and everybody goes crazy buying everything in every store.

The checklist on the left gives you some ideas of what to buy and store in a plastic tub or two. Keep the tub handy and you will be prepared if bad weather strikes.

Remember some of the hard lessons learned 10 years ago. Before the storm: fill your car's fuel tank; get some cash; bring all loose items (lawn furniture, toys, etc.) inside; charge your cell phones, let your out-of-town relatives know if you plan on sheltering at home or evacuating.

After the storm: Don't count on government aid for the first 72 hours. You'll appreciate your disaster kit.

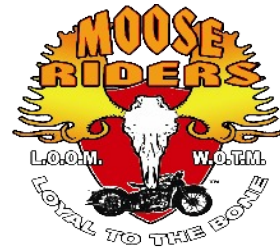



