Offices to be filled are: Governor, Jr. Governor, Prelate, Treasurer, 3-Year Trustee (The 1 and 2-Year Trustees positions are filled).

Eligibility for these elected officers can be found in Moose General Laws §33.5.


Our Man of The Month is **Paul Stevens.** Paul is an asset to our lodge and is always here to lend a hand.


