
Every donation helps, so give what you can. Thanks

We have received some donations for the building fund. Not many, but we're just getting started and every donation counts.

If you have wondered why we want to pay off the mortgage and how your donation can help, consider the following.

- •Paying interest is not tax deductible for us, it's money down the drain.
- •Should a bigger piece of property become available for a Lodge home, we can't buy it or contract to buy it because we making payments on the current loan.
- •Making the loan payment during the off season is painful because our income is severely reduced but our expenses are not.
- •Money not paid to a mortgage can be deposited into our building fund so we can secure the future of our Lodge.

You may have seen the new street lights and walkway between our service road and Tamiami Trail. Coming next are small parking lots. The city has a grant to complete the project and, hopefully, by the end of the year we'll have additional parking as shown below. The lots will be public and open to first come, first served.


