Brothers, what is the Moose Legion?

The Moose Legion is comprised of male members who roll up their sleeves and get things done. You cannot advance in the Moose fraternity to the Fellowship or Pilgrim degree unless you join the Moose Legion. The Moose Legion also provides for the endowment fund and sporting events for our

children at Mooseheart. Annual dues in the Moose Legion are only \$17 for a total of \$67 a year when combined with your Moose membership dues. If you join the Moose Legion you will receive a 50¢ discount on your drinks on Sunday, except draft beer, and a \$1 discount on Saturday breakfast. The saving will more than pay for your dues each year, so see any officer and join today. Let's make it happen.

Ladies, what is the Women of the Moose/Chapter?

Moose Chapter 1892. So let's make it happen.

The Women of the Moose form a Chapter at every Moose Lodge. Chapter members are the women that make the difference in the lives of our seniors at Moosehaven by helping provide the money for medication for our seniors and so many other needs. We need to keep our chapter strong and growing. It only costs \$15 a year to be a Chapter member, so for a total of \$65 (Lodge dues plus Chapter dues) a year you can make a big difference in the lives of our seniors at Moosehaven. Once you join the Chapter, you will receive 50¢ off all your drinks on Sundays, except draft beer, and a \$1 discount on your Saturday breakfast at the Lodge.
